2013 Matt Davis Award Winner: Jimmy Marshall

2013 marked the naming of the 19th recipient of the Matt Davis Award. Basketball player Jimmy Marshall was named as the recipient at the Douglas Freeman High School Senior Awards Night in June. A team captain, Marshall averaged 16 points, six rebounds and four assists per game as a senior, earning first team all-district, second team all-region and third team all-metro honors. He helped lead the Rebels to a district title and two regional semi-finals appearances. One website wrote about Marshall, "Simply put, [he] is a coach's dream. He has great basketball IQ, tremendous attitude, and a strong work ethic combined with the skill and athleticism." Marshall overcame injuries during his high school career to achieve his dream of a Division-I basketball scholarship.
